SPONSORSHIP FOR VOLUNTARY SERVICE PROJECTS

The Edward Alleyn Club, the alumni association of Alleyn's School, is once again offering support to students who wish to undertake voluntary service projects after they leave school, either during the summer vacation or in their year off before starting work or university.

If you are in your last year at school and would like to apply for such sponsorship, you should send your application to Miss Sue Lane, by email – slane3161@gmail.com

The letter of application should include:

- Your name, address, contact telephone number and email address.
- Details of the nature of the project you wish to undertake
- Whether it is organised by a particular group, and if so, the name of the organisation involved
- The anticipated dates of the project
- Why you believe your chosen project deserves the Club's support, in particular your reasons for undertaking this project
- Why you believe that you are worthy of support. (This could include relevant A level subjects, work experience, CCF, Duke of Edinburgh Award or voluntary service experience)
- Higher Education plans
- The total amount of finance required
- The amount already raised, and
- The maximum amount of sponsorship sought from the Club.

Applicants should be reminded that sponsorship is mainly awarded on the quality and substance of your written application.

The applications will be considered by a small committee. The committee members hope to be able to have an informal meeting with the short listed candidates before you go on study leave. The amount awarded to any individual may be a proportion of the amount requested, depending on the number of successful applications and the amount of money requested. Applicants will be notified of the Club's decision as soon as possible after the informal meetings. It would be much appreciated if those who receive sponsorship could send a short report on their project, while it is being undertaken or when it has been completed, to the editor of the Club's Magazine, alumni@alleyns.org.uk, so that the Club can be informed of the use to which its money is being put.

Applications to be submitted by the first Friday of the Trinity Term and it is important that you submit your application on time. If your plans are incomplete please write to me telling me of your intention to apply and giving details of how far you have got with your application.
