Travel By Bicycle or Scooter

We encourage visitors to cycle or scoot to the Alleyn's where possible, and there are plenty of cycle bays located around the site. To ensure the safety of pupils, staff and visitors, bicycles and scooters must be dismounted at the entrance and walked while on school grounds. A separate cycle entrance is available at Townley Lodge to help reduce congestion at busy times. Please ensure cycles are locked when parked; the School cannot accept responsibility for any bicycles left on the premises.

Travel By Car

Roads around Alleyn's have traffic and parking controls, including timed restrictions, so please consider if driving is necessary and follow all signage.

Townley Road to East Dulwich Grove Junction

The junction from Townley Road to East Dulwich Grove is closed to cars from 8:00am to 9:00am and 3:00pm to 4:30pm, Monday to Friday. Cameras monitor this junction, and fines are automatically issued to unauthorised vehicles. The School cannot appeal these fines. Restrictions apply all year-round including during the school holidays.



Vehicle restrictions on **Townley Road**, leading to East Dulwich Grove, are active on weekdays from Monday to Friday, from 8:00 am to 9:00 am and 3:00 pm to 4:30 pm, these also apply during school holidays.

Controlled Parking Zones (CPZs)

Southwark Council manages two different Controlled Parking Zones (CPZs) covering roads around the Senior and Junior School entrances. These areas are regularly patrolled by traffic wardens. Restrictions apply all year-round.

Dulwich Village CPZ

- Location: Near the Senior School entrance
- Roads include: Townley Road, Calton Avenue, Gilkes Crescent, Gilkes Place, part of East Dulwich Road, and Dulwich Village (near to the shops).
- Operating hours: Monday to Friday, 8:00am to 9:30am and 3:00pm to 5:00pm
- Paid parking: Limited paid bays available with a maximum stay of approximately two hours.

East Dulwich CPZ

- Location: Near the Junior School entrance
- Roads include: Hillsboro Road, Thorncombe Road, Glengarry Road, Tarbert Road, Trossachs Road, and Green Dale.
- Operating hours: Monday to Friday, 8:30 am to 6:30 pm

Outside controlled hours, parking may be available. Please check local signs and park considerately, especially with regard to neighbours and children leaving the school.

Coach Bays on Townley Road

Coach bays are clearly marked and reserved for coaches during specific times.

- 'Field side' coach bay: Monday to Friday, 8:00am to 10:00am and 3:00pm to 6:00pm
- 'School side' coach bay: Monday to Saturday, 8:00am to 10:00am and 3:00pm to 6:00pm
- Outside of these days and hours, other vehicles may use the spaces.
- Restrictions apply year-round

Hillsboro' Road School Street | Alleyn's Term Only

Hillsboro' Road is a School Street, restricting access during Alleyn's term time from 8:00am to 8:45am and 3:15pm to 5:00pm. Only permit holders, including School vehicles, may drive through, with cameras enforcing the rule.

Parking within the School Grounds

Parking within the school grounds is primarily reserved for visitors who have additional needs or medical conditions and who have arranged parking in advance. Please see the **Accessibility and Additional Assistance** section below for details on how to arrange this.

General parking for non-accessibility reasons is extremely limited and only possible by prior agreement for specific events or bookings. Equipment drop-off, where vehicles do not remain on site, is available by prior arrangement and is not subject to the same restrictions.

In both cases, hirers should contact their event lead/contact, who will liaise with our Concierge team to confirm availability and arrangements.

Accessibility and Additional Assistance

We are committed to ensuring all visitors have a welcoming and accessible experience at Alleyn's.

If you or anyone in your group has specific access or parking needs, please email the Concierge team in advance at commissionaires@alleyns.org.uk and copy your event lead/contact.

The Concierge team are based at Townley Lodge. Sharing details in advance helps us plan effectively. For urgent, same-day assistance, please speak to staff at Townley Lodge on arrival.

When contacting us, please provide details of your particular needs, such as mobility requirements, accessible parking, or any specific assistance you might require during your visit.

To help us plan effectively, please include:

- Your name and preferred contact details
- Date and time of your intended visit
- The activity, event or booking you're attending
- Vehicle details if parking is needed (registration number, make, model, and colour)
- Nature of your access requirements (e.g., wheelchair access, limited walking distances, visual or hearing impairments, relevant medical conditions)
- Number of accompanying visitors (if applicable)
- Any specific assistance required upon arrival or during your visit (such as help with directions, reserved seating, induction loops, quiet spaces, or any other adjustments)
- Any specific requirements in the event of an emergency

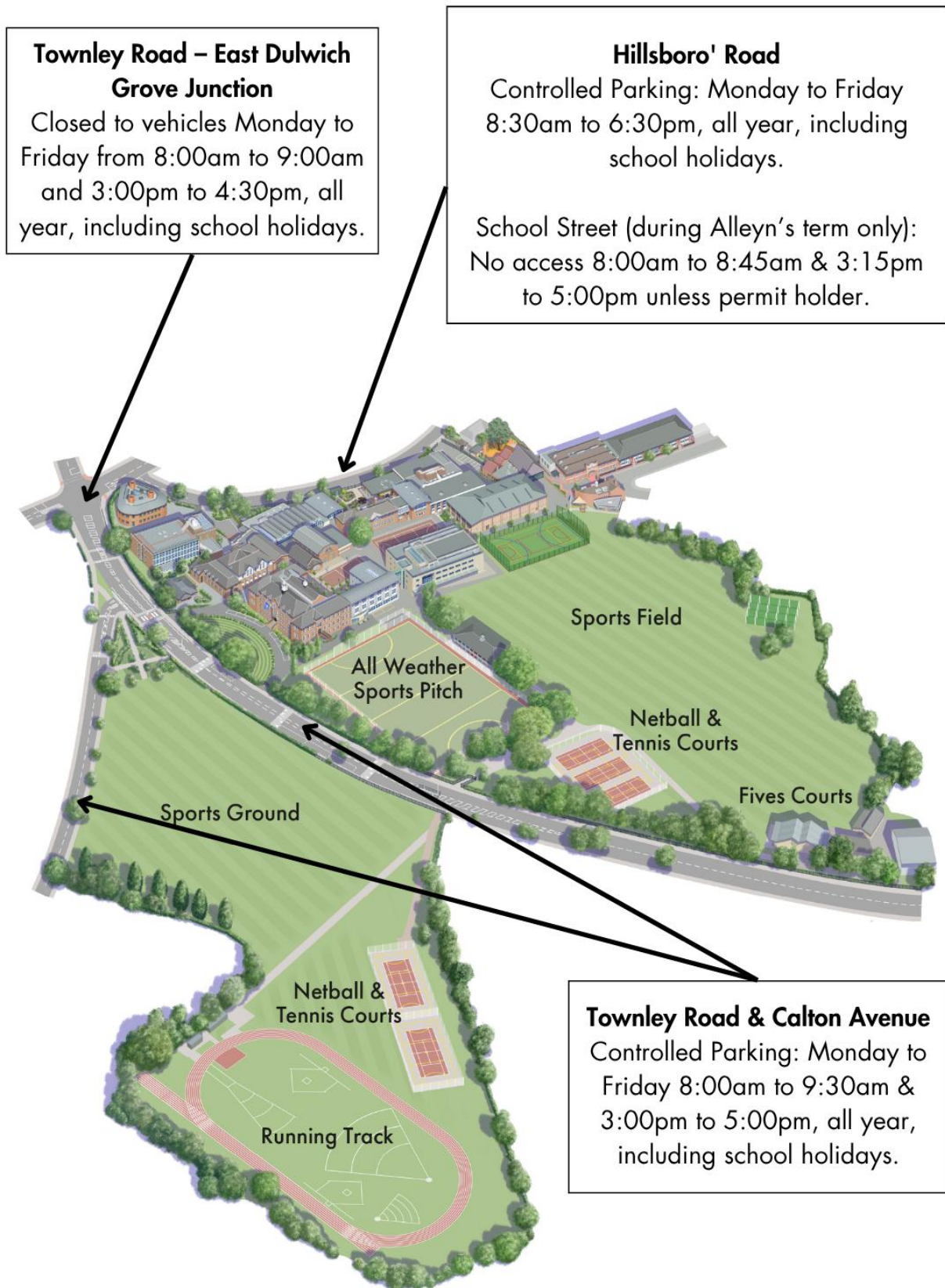
Once we have received your details, our staff will liaise with you directly to ensure suitable arrangements are in place, making your visit as comfortable and enjoyable as possible. This includes:

- **Accessible Parking:** Clearly marked accessible parking spaces are available and can be reserved in advance.
- **Assistance on Arrival:** Staff at Townley Lodge (main entrance) or event-specific staff will be available to assist you with directions, navigation, or any immediate support you may need.
- **Guide and Assistance Dogs:** Guide and assistance dogs are warmly welcomed on site.
